

5 Steps to Review ASQ®

Complete the following steps to check for accuracy of ASQ®-3 results prior to making follow-up decisions with parents.

 1. Check the child's age compared to the age range on ASQ-3* Was the child's age calculated correctly? Was age adjusted for prematurity? Is the child's age at the young end of the age range?
 2. Review Not Yet and omitted items
Did the child try the items?Is the item appropriate to the family's culture?
 3. If needed, offer time to try items and/or omit items Re-score areas if the child demonstrates skills. Adjust the area total using ratio scoring if any items were omitted.
 4. Review and discuss ASQ-3 Overall SectionWhat are the parent and/or provider concerns?
 5. Consider factors that may impact results Child health Stress or trauma Child's behavior Home language Other
